

#### REPAIRING FABRIC BY HAND



The backstitch is a handy hand-sewing technique perfect for repairs. It creates a strong, continuous seam that holds two pieces of fabric together securely. Its small, back-and-forth stitches make it the strongest basic stitch, ideal for fixing tears, securing hems, and mending seams.

backstitch, start by making a stitch on the wrong side of the fabric and pulling the thread through until you have a small loop. Then, insert your needle through that loop and pull the thread through again until you have another small loop.
