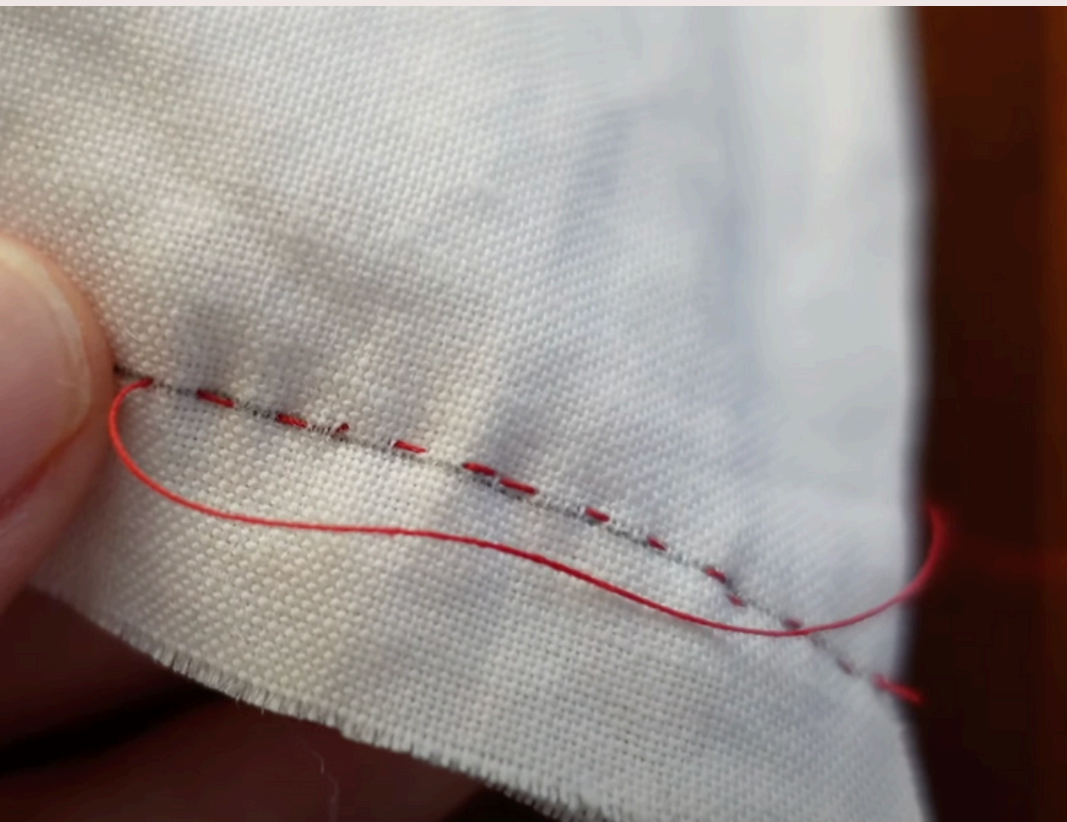
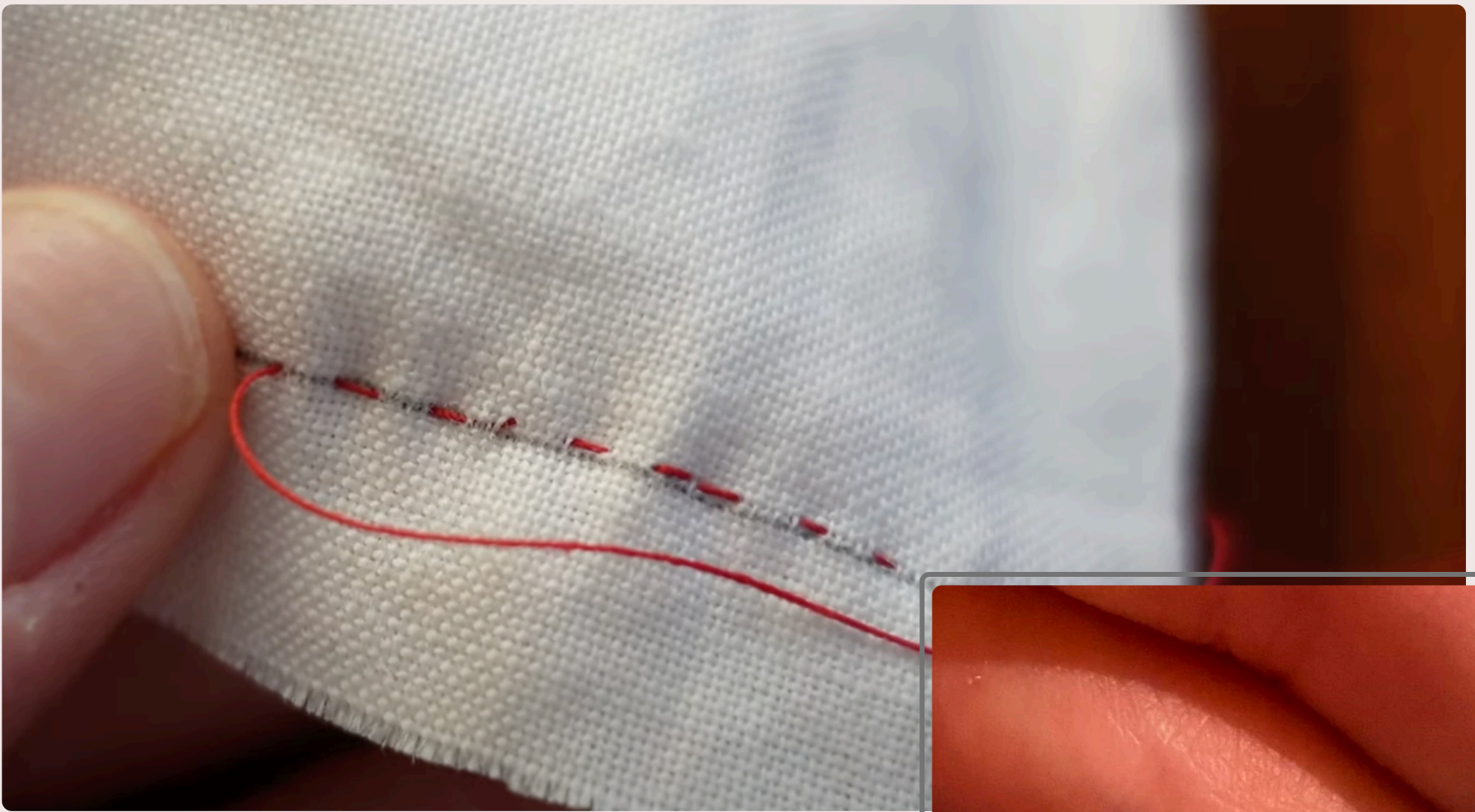


BACK STITCH USED FOR PDF



SEAM STITCHING HAND



A backstitch helps in making seam stitching by creating a very strong and durable line of stitches. That's what even back stitch in cross stitch is also used for. This is because the stitch overlaps slightly, reinforcing the seam and making it less likely to come apart.



REPAIRING FABRIC BY HAND



The backstitch is a handy hand-sewing technique perfect for repairs. It creates a strong, continuous seam that holds two pieces of fabric together securely. Its small, back-and-forth stitches make it the strongest basic stitch, ideal for fixing tears, securing hems, and mending seams.

SECURING FABRIC WITH BACKSTITCH



To make a secure fabric with a backstitch, start by making a stitch on the wrong side of the fabric and pulling the thread through until you have a small loop. Then, insert your needle through that loop and pull the thread through again until you have another small loop.
